RANCH HORSE SHOW RULES

Governed by the SHTX Rulebook (primary), then by current Colorado 4-H Rule Book (secondary).

All enrolled Adams County 4-H contestants 18 & Under are REQUIRED to wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet with a safety harness for all divisions and disciplines. Open and non-4-H members are strongly encouraged to wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet with safety harness in the English & Western Divisions. All contestants are required to wear proper English or Western attire, including boots, pants, and long sleeved collared shirts (chest and midriff must be covered). Please refer to the CO 4-H Rule Book for additional tack/attire specifications.

Class entries – Exhibitors can enter multiple horses into the same classes. Each horse/rider combo must be registered and have an assigned number. Points are accumulated on a one horse/one rider basis.

Fees:

Office Fee—\$20.00/horse & rider combo

SHTX Membership—\$30.00 (required if showing in CoWN classes)

CoWN Membership—\$25.00 (optional)

ADCO Membership—\$15.00 Individual or \$30.00 Family (optional)

Stalls—\$25.00/night

Shavings—TBD

Cattle classes—\$30.00/run

ALL DAY FEES: SAVINGS OF \$45/division if you enter both organization's classes

Saturday Divisions: Open/Non-Pro/Limited Non-Pro/Intermediate Non-Pro/Intermediate Youth—\$20.00/class/organization

OR All Day Fee/Division (for both organizations—8+ classes) - \$245 ****SAVINGS OF \$45/division****

Sunday Divisions: Youth (18&U)/Novice Adult/Non-Pro Junior/Open Junior—\$15.00/class/organization

OR All Day Fee/Division (for both organizations—8+ classes) - \$200 ****SAVINGS OF \$45/division****

SHTX Membership is required in order to compete in CoWN classes.

NO REFUNDS! Open checks or Credit Cards on file are highly encouraged. For those that leave an open check - scratched classes that are done in the show office will not be charged. Office charge and cattle fees will not be refunded. No back numbers will be issued until open check/credit card/cash payment is made.

Co-Op Membership - This Co-Op is an opportunity for exhibitors wishing to earn Year End Discipline and Overall Championship Awards. Membership is required before points begin to accrue, and is not retroactive. Membership is not required for Daily Hi-Point Awards. Individual Membership is \$15 annually, or a Family (2+) is \$30 annually.

Daily High Point winners will be announced. ADCO Divisions for daily high point include: 8-10, 11-13, 14-18, Novice Adult, Intermediate Youth, Intermediate Non-Pro, Non-Pro, and Open. CoWN Divisions for daily high point include: 13 & Under, 14-18, Novice Adult, Intermediate Non-Pro, Limited Non-Pro, Non-Pro, Open, Junior Horse Open, and Junior Horse Non-Pro. Overall placings (ie: Top 5, Top 10) and awards will be based on number of exhibitors in each age division. Points will be maintained and accumulated on a one horse/one rider basis.

Ranch Horse Discipline Year End Championship - points earned in each Ranch Horse show, based on one horse/one rider combo, will accumulate toward the 2018 Adams County Horse Show Series Division awards. These awards will be given for 8-10, 11-13, 14-18, Novice Adult, Intermediate Youth, Intermediate Non-Pro, Non-Pro, and Open season winners.

Overall Year End Championship – points earned from all shows in the series, based on one horse/one rider combo, will count toward the 2018 Adams County Horse Show Series Overall Championship awards. Awards will be given for age groups: 8-10, 11-13, 14-18, and 19 & Over season winners.
