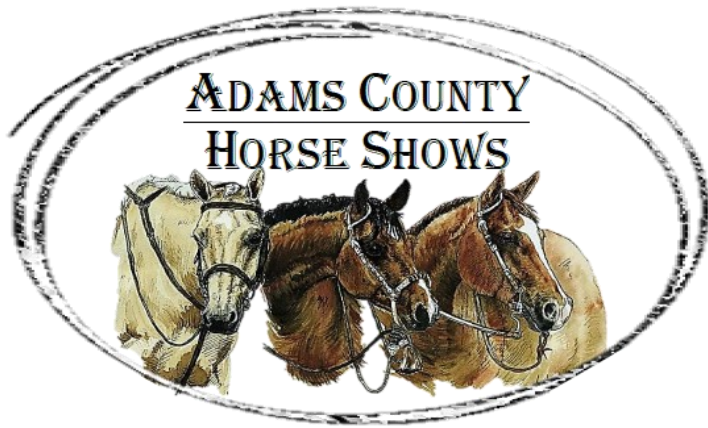

RANCH HORSE RULES

Governed by the SHTX Rulebook (primary), then by current Colorado 4-H Rule Book (secondary).

All enrolled Adams County 4-H contestants 18 & Under are REQUIRED to wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet with a safety harness for all divisions and disciplines. Open and non-4-H members are strongly encouraged to wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet with safety harness in the Ranch Horse Division. All contestants are required to wear proper attire. Please refer to the SHTX Rulebook for tack/attire specifications.

Class entries – Exhibitors can enter multiple horses into the same classes. Each horse/rider combo must be registered and have an assigned number. Points are accumulated on a one horse/one rider basis.

Fees:

Office Fee—\$20.00/horse & rider combo

SHTX/CoWN Office Fee—\$20.00/horse & rider combo (if you desire to have points submitted to CoWN/SHTX)

SHTX Membership—\$30.00 (required for SHTX/CoWN points)

CoWN Membership—\$25.00 (required for CoWN Year End points)

ADCO Membership—\$15.00 Individual or \$30.00 Family (required for ADCO Year End points)

Stalls—\$25.00/night

Shavings—TBD

Cattle Class Fees —\$55.00/class

Non-Cattle Class Fees —\$20.00/class

SHTX Membership is required for those competing for SHTX/CoWN points.

NO REFUNDS! An open signed check or credit card form must be on file before numbers will be distributed. Credit Cards will be processed at the end of the day with a 4% service charge added.

Co-Op Membership - This Co-Op is an opportunity for exhibitors wishing to earn Year End Overall Championship Awards. Membership is required before points begin to accrue, and is not retroactive. Membership is not required for Daily Hi-Point Awards. Individual Membership is \$15 annually, or a Family (2+) is \$30 annually.

Class awards 1st through 6th place winners can select a ribbon or show bucks from the ribbon shack. Show bucks provide a monetary value based on class placing, and can be redeemed from Show Me Twice before 12/31/19.

Daily High Point winners will be announced. Daily high points include: Novice Youth, Youth, Novice Adult, Intermediate Non-Pro, Limited Non-Pro, Non-Pro, Junior Horse Non-Pro, Junior Horse Open, and Open. Overall placings (ie: Top 5, Top 10) and awards will be based on number of exhibitors in each age division. Points will be maintained and accumulated on a one horse/one rider basis.

Overall Year End Championship – points earned from all shows in the series, based on one horse/one rider combo, will count toward the 2019 Adams County Horse Show Series Overall Championship awards. All 6 shows in the series count towards this title. Awards will be given for age groups: 8-10, 11-13, 14-18, and 19 & Over season winners.
